EXTRACURRICULAR  
ACTIVITY ABSENCES

The District shall make no distinction between absences for UIL activities and absences for other extracurricular activities approved by the Board. A student shall be allowed in a school year a maximum of ten extracurricular absences not related to post-district competition, a maximum of five absences for post-district competition prior to state, and a maximum of two absences for state competition.

USE OF DISTRICT  
FACILITIES

School-sponsored student groups may use District facilities with prior approval of the appropriate administrator. Other student groups may use District facilities in accordance with policy FNAB.

CURRICULUM-  
RELATED CLUBS AND  
ORGANIZATIONS

Curriculum-related student organizations or clubs may be organized on secondary campuses as need and interest dictate. The formation of all clubs and organizations shall have the approval of the principal. No club may organize without a faculty sponsor. [See also FNAB for requirements for noncurriculum-related groups]

CONSTITUTION AND  
BYLAWS

All curriculum-related school clubs or organizations shall place on file with the appropriate assistant principal a copy of the club or organization constitution and bylaws and a current list of officers and members.

CLUB MEETINGS

Clubs shall meet before or after school, at night, or at any time outside the regular school day. No class periods shall be set aside for curriculum-related club activities.

HONORS OR  
ADVANCED COURSES

A principal may grant an exemption in accordance with State Board rules and allow a student in an honors or advanced class, as specified by the state and identified in the student handbook, to participate in extracurricular activities, even if the student earns a grade less than 70 but not lower than 60.
