

## MUSIC HONORS DEADLINES

2009—2010

Students: Remember that while Honors Music can give you the extra points you may desire for your GPA, you must be self-motivated and disciplined in your work as a Music Honors student. If you miss deadlines or do not complete all of the requirements for Honors, your grade may be lower than if you had taken this class for regular credit instead of Honors credit. It is your responsibility, not that of your director, to see that you meet all of the requirements in a timely manner.

Aug. 25-Sept. 11	Turn in Honors Credit application Pick up Theory study packet
Sept. 14-Sept. 18	Take Theory Test (The Honors Music Coordinator on your campus will set the date.)
Sept. 21-Sept. 25	Theory Test Retake (if needed)
Sept. 28	Applications sent to Fine Arts Director Counselors notified of Applicants
Dec. 1	Research Paper Due (Have subject approved prior to completing paper.)
Dec. 8	First Concert Evaluation Due
Dec. 14	Counselors notified of any drops
Jan. 26	Two performance selections chosen. Honors Coordinator notified of selections.
May 6	Third Concert Evaluation Due
May 27	Public Performance Due The Music Honors Coordinator on your campus will set a recital date for those students who have not had their public performance.

Please note that there is no deadline date for your 2<sup>nd</sup> concert attendance. This may be done at any time during the year; all performance attendance critiques must be complete by May 6<sup>th</sup>.
