

**Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo™**  
**School Art Program**  
**QUICK DRAW CONTEST RULES**

1 Any high school student enrolled in a public independent school district, private school or  
parochial school that is registered as a participant in the current Houston Livestock Show  
and Rodeo School Art Program may apply. Current enrollment in an art class is not a  
requirement.

2 Applicants must have a social security number (SSN) or an individual tax identification  
number (ITIN) in order to enter the contest and to receive cash prizes. S numbers are not  
accepted. In order for you to compete in the contest, these tax numbers will be provided  
and W-9's will be completed at the sign-in table on contest day.

3 The applicant must return a 10-minute sketch on an 8.5x11 sheet of white paper with their  
application.

4 The contest will have two classes:

Still Life Class

Portrait/Figurative Class

5 Students may enter only one class

6 Applications will be accepted through the end of November 2006. Notification of  
acceptance for the contest will be given to all applicants in January 2007.

7 Twenty-five finalists will be chosen in each class for a total of fifty finalists. A minimum of 5  
entries in a class is required in order for that class to be judged.

8 Students selected as finalists must be academically eligible to participate according to  
TEA/UIL eligibility guidelines. Finalists will be required to provide proof of eligibility on the  
day of the contest. An eligibility form will be provided by HLSR.

9 The contest will be held in Reliant Center during the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo  
Bar-B-Que Cook-off, February 22-24, 2007. The exact date, time and location will be  
provided at a later date.

10 Three School Art Committee Judges will set up the "still life" and "portrait/figurative"  
models.

11 Three different School Art Committee Judges will judge the Quick Draw Contest.

12 All finalists will receive a blue, red or white award ribbon.

13 Each class will have a Class Champion and a Reserve Class Champion.

14 From the Class Champions, there will be one Quick Draw Champion selected.

15 These Championship Awards will be presented immediately following the judging.

16 The cash prizes, which will be mailed after the Show, are as follows:

Reserve Class Champion           \$250.00

Class Champion                   \$500.00

Quick Draw Champion           \$750.00

Additionally, 10 scholarships to the Glassell School of Art will be awarded.

17 All champion art will become the property of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo. A  
student submitting art that is selected as a champion will receive a copy of their art.

18 Quick Draw Contest Champions will be displayed in the Hayloft Gallery for the remainder of  
the Show.
