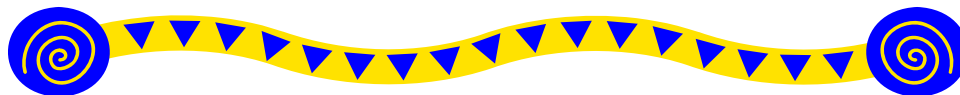

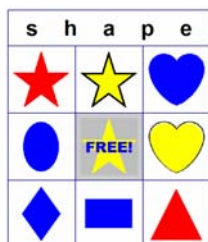

## Alphabet Children

### Instructions

Have kids use their bodies to form letters. This can involve a single child or a group of kids. Place dowel rods or rope on top of students to outline the letter. Take picture with digital camera and import picture into PowerPoint. On the left of the slide, type an upper and lower case letter in 48 font. See example



## How Many Will Fit?

### Estimation/Spatial Sense

- ★ Select a spot such as a bench, wide step
- ★ Ask children to predict how many of them will fit on it.
- ★ Check to see how many will fit.
- ★ Discuss guesses (realistic?)
- ★ Take two pictures
  - One of space with no children
  - One with children filling it



## Identifying "real life" sets

Walk around the school searching for objects

- ★ swing set
  - ★ bike rack
  - ★ windows
  - ★ doors
1. Photograph these sets
  2. Download digital images
  3. Count the objects in each set
- Label the images using text box in application
