
## **Five Things You Should Know About Word 2010**

## 3. How Do I Turn Off Double-Spacing Each Time I Press Enter?

Some people are bothered by the fact that when you press Enter, the text moves down double-spaced. You can change that setting by adjusting the Style Set back to Word 2003.




On the Home tab, click the Change Styles button

Left click Style Set → Word 2003

Change To keep this setting for ALL documents, click Change Styles button again and choose Set As Default Styles ▼

## Why Can't the Menus Look Like They Used To? - They can! (sort of...)




I call it "the good ol' days" button

In many of the Tool Groups (like the Paragraph group pictured at the left), there is a "good ol' days" button in the bottom right corner.

Click this button to reveal the tool menu as it was in Word 2003.
