- No. 31** **TERRY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP** *Deadline: 01-26-09*
This scholarship is for 2009 graduates of Texas high schools who demonstrate scholastic achievement, leadership ability and financial need. Must plan on attending University of Houston as a full-time student for 2009-2010, have a record of leadership in school community, strong academic abilities, as evidenced by grades and SAT scores, financial need, reside on campus for the first year, U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident of the U.S.
- No. 32** **THE KOH FAMILY SCHOLARSHIPS** *Deadline: 01-05-09*
Scholarship in the amount of \$10,000/year for four years of undergraduate study and up to five years for dual degree programs. Criteria: Must attend TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0, entering Freshman should have a min. ACT of 32 or SAT of 1400, and must pursue a full time study in an engineering discipline.
- No. 33** **THE NATIONAL CO-OP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** *Deadline: 02-06-09*
To be eligible for a merit Co-op Scholarship a student must apply and be accepted at one of the ten (10) NCCE Partner Colleges and Universities: C.W. Post Campus of Long Island University, Johnson & Wales University, Northeastern University, Rochester Institute of Technology, University of Toledo, Drexel University, Kettering university, Pace University, University of Cincinnati, Wentworth Institute of technology.
