2009 Program Requirements

To be eligible to apply, ALL new applicants must:

- Be between the ages of 15 – 18
- Submit a paper application with legal guardian's signature
- Provide two letters of recommendation. Letters must be from a teacher/professor or school counselor
- Provide a copy of most recent report card with a minimum B average (80 or above)

Returning Applicants from previous summer

- Be between the ages of 15 – 18
- Provide a copy of most recent report card with a minimum B average (80 or above)

The first 100 applicants that satisfactorily meet all the requirements will be accepted. Applicants have the choice of completing a paper or online application.
