The Board shall ensure that a District improvement plan and improvement plans for each campus are developed, reviewed, and revised annually for the purpose of improving the performance of all students.

II. Funding Requirement

E-RATE

Texas schools and charter schools are required to have an approved technology plan to

participate in the federal Universal Service Fund program, commonly known as the E-Rate program. The Texas Education Agency is authorized to approve these plans by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) which administers the program under the direction of the Federal Communications Commission.

No Child Left Behind

Under the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, Title II, Part D, Enhancing Education Through Technology, the law states that in order to be eligible to receive a subgrant from the State educational agency, a local educational agency or eligible local entity shall submit to the State educational agency an application containing a new or updated local long-range strategic educational technology plan that is consistent with the objectives of the statewide educational plan and compliant with NCLB criteria.
